THE VINTAGE

Understanding and succeeding this vintage required, indeed, presence in the Vineyard, careful work, experience, and even, clearly, a genuine expertise... Winter temperatures amongst the mildest in the decade, rainfall amounts amongst the highest ever in winter, among the lowest ever in spring, and a nice output of grapes throughout the Rhone cépages: everything would raise hope of an early vintage, the ever expected Vintage, satisfactory both in terms of quantity and of quality! But it was not counting on an unusually cool and rainy summer... Vignerons are soon confronted with quite a few difficulties, the trickiest one being the management of diseases..

North winds coupled with a lovely late summer make forget this atypical summer. The grapes reach an excellent phenolic maturity.

The vines were in demand. It was crucial to understand, to be able to anticipate...

This required a bit of wisdom, reason, intuition...
